Care & Handling for Peaches

Always handle peaches gently— they bruise easily. Look through your box of peaches and remove any that are bruised or soft. Be sure to eat these first. Unlike citrus fruit, peaches

continue to ripen after they're picked. Our peaches are picked with full color and sugar content, but still firm enough to handle without damage. They need a day or two at room temperature to finish ripening and be ready to eat.

Ripen Peaches at Room Temp

DO NOT refrigerate unripe peaches. Instead, spread them out on your countertop and check them regularly until they reach your desired level of ripeness (1 to 3 days). Keep a watchful eye on them.

After Ripening

Refrigerate ripe peaches to extend shelf life but watch for wrinkling around the stem or other signs that peaches are dehydrating— they can dry out and become mealy in the refrigerator. Don't store whole peaches in plastic bags in your refrigerator, as this can keep them damp and encourage mold growth. Freeze or can peaches for extended storage.

Storing Pecans

Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator for 9-10 months or freeze for 18-24 months.

Storing Blueberries

Rinse them well, dry them, and refrigerate for up to a week, or freeze for 4-6 months.
